- **Alt** = Alternate
- **Approx** = Approximately

B

- **Beg** = Beginning
- **Bet** = Between
- **BO** = Bind off/cast off
- **Byo** = Backward yarn over.

C

- **CC** = Contrasting color
- **ch** = Chain
- **cm** = Centimeter
- **cn** = Cable needle
- **CO** = Cast on
- **Cont** = Continue

D

- **dec** = Decrease
- **DK** = Double knitting
- **dpn**- Double pointed needles.

E

- **Eon** = End of needle

F

- **FC** = Front cross
- **Foll** = Following

G

- **g** = Grams (weight)
- **grp** = Group
- **g st**= Garter stitch

I

- **in** = Inches
- **inc** = Increase
- **incl** = Including

K

- **k** = Knit
- **k1B** = Knit 1 stitch into the row below
- **kfb** = Knit into the front and back of a stitch
- **K tbl** = Knit through the back loop of a stitch
- **k2 tog** = Knit two stitches together

L

- **LC** = Left cross
- **LH** = Left-hand
- **lp, lps** = Loop, loops

M

- **m** = Meter(s)
- **M1K** = Make one stitch knitwise
- **M1R** = Make one right
- **M1L** = Make one left
- **M1p** = Make one purlwise, a single purl increase.
- **M1rp** = Make one right purlwise
- **M1lp** = Make one left purlwise
- **MB** = Make bobble
- **MC** = Main color
- **mm** = Millimeter.

N

- **no** = number

O

- **oz** = ounce

P

- **p** = purl stitch
- **p2tog** = Purl two together
- **pat** = Pattern
- **p-b** = Purl into the stitch below
- **pfb** = Purl into the front and back of a stitch.
- **pm** = Place marker
- **pns** = Pass next stitch over.
- **prev** = Previous
- **pss** = Pass slip stitch over
- **ptbl** = Purl through back loop
- **pwise** = Purlwise

R

- **RC** = Right cross
- **rem** = Remaining
- **rep** = Repeat
- **Rev st st** = Reverse stockinette stitch
- **RH** = Right hand
- **rib** = Ribbing
- **rnd(s)** = Round
- **RS** = Right side

S

- **SKP** = Slip one knitwise
- **SK2P** = Slip one knitwise
- **sl** = Slip
- **sl1k** = Slip one knitwise.
- **sl1p** = Slip one purlwise.
- **sl st** = Slip stitch.
- **sp** = Space
- **ssk** = Slip the next two stitches, one at a time, knitwise, onto the right-hand needle. Then knit these together.
- **st(s)** = Stitch(es)
- **St st** = Stockinette stitch.

T

- **tbl** = Through the back loop of the stitch.
- **tfl** = Through the front loop of the stitch.
- **tog** = Together

W

- **WS** = Wrong side
- **w&t** = Wrap and turn
- **won** = Wool over needle
- **wrn** = Wool round needle
- **wyib** = With yarn in the back.
- **wyif** = With yarn in front

Y

- **yb (ybk)** = Yarn to back
- **yf (yfd)** = Yarn to the front
- **yo** = Yarn over
- **yo2** = Yarn over twice
- **yon** = Yarn over the needle
- **yrn** = Yarn round needle

- ***** = Repeat the instruction following the * as directed.
- ****** = Repeat the instruction between * and * as many times as directed.
- **() ; [], or {}** = Work the instructions between the brackets as many times as directed.
